WHAT TO RECYCLE @ CURBSIDE . . . Single Stream recycling will allow residents to put paper and cardboard; with bottles, cans and plastic jugs (No.'s 1 thru 7) in the same container. Additional items which the Single Stream Program will accept include: books, narrow-neck plastic containers; wide-mouth plastic containers; aluminum foil, aluminum foil pans and rigid plastic such as outdoor furniture, coolers, garbage cans, drinking cups, pails, 5-gallon buckets, flower pots, and plastic toys.

METAL		Aluminum and steel food and beverage cans, New : <u>EMPTY aerosol cans, (clean/rinsed) aluminum foil and pie pans</u>		NO -- Propane cylinders, pots and pans, scrap metal
GLASS		<u>Glass, Jars & Bottles</u> All food and beverage jars and bottles of all colors.		NO -- Dishes, ceramics, drinking glasses, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, crystal, cookware (such as Corningware™, Pyrex®)
PLASTIC		Narrow-neck bottles and jugs with #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 inside triangle on or near the bottom such as soda and detergent bottles and milk jugs. <u>WIDE-MOUTH PLASTIC CONTAINERS</u> (such as butter, cottage cheese, peanut butter, yogurt, mayonnaise, sour cream, and whipped topping containers), <u>RIGID PLASTICS</u> (such as buckets [with or without metal handles], drinking cups, flower pots, coolers, drums, 5-gallon water bottles, lawn furniture, pallets, plastic window well covers, and toys) <u>Note: laundry baskets, garbage containers and recycling containers will be collected for recycling IF a note requesting this is prominently attached.</u>		NO -- Plastic bags, Styrofoam™ (including but not limited to bowls, cups, plates, to-go containers, and foam packing material of any kind), clam shells (such as packaging for toys and batteries, as well as salad bar plastic containers), CD jewel cases, motor oil containers, VHS tapes, plastic electronics, candy wrappers, food wrappers, plastic cutlery (forks, knives, spoons), beverage can plastic ring holders, bubble wrap.
PAPER		Newspapers (including all inserts), magazines, phone books, catalogs, books (including paperbacks, textbooks and hardbacks), writing and computer paper, mail, paperboard (e.g., cereal, frozen food, and shoe boxes), cardboard (flattened), milk and juice cartons/boxes, cardstock, copy paper (including NCR - No Carbon Required - copy paper), envelopes (plastic windows ok), fax paper, ice cream containers, letterhead paper, non-metallic wrapping paper, paper bags		NO -- Paper or cardboard covered by wax, plastic, or food*; Kleenex®; foil gift wrap, photo paper *Note: milk and juice cartons/boxes are NOT covered with wax or plastic; different manufacturers have different techniques for achieving the polished look on the exterior.
