**** \$25.00 Fee Due at Time of Application ****

Pursuant to the 2010 Development Regulations, Ordinance No. 730-10, Section 10, Subsection 165-68.B.10, the Planning Department may issue a temporary (6 months) permit to park or store one inoperative or untagged motor vehicle on any lot of less than two (2) acres in a residential district. A temporary (6 month) permit may be issued for each of two (2) inoperative or untagged motor vehicles on any lot of two (2) acres or more in a residential district. Inoperative or untagged vehicles parked or stored within a completely enclosed building are permitted and do not require a permit.

Property owners wishing to store inoperative or untagged vehicles outside of an enclosed building must obtain a permit from the Town of Bel Air Department of Planning. Permits will be used for a six (6) month period only. The fee for each permit is \$25.00 per vehicle. Upon expiration of the permit, the vehicle must be operative and tagged or removed from the property. The Town will not issue additional permits for the same vehicle under any circumstances. Persons storing vehicles without the appropriate permit shall be found in violation of Ordinance No. 730-10 and subject to a fine of not more than \$400.00 per day for each day the violation continues.
